

# Step-By-Step Guide to Renaming the Boat

#### What You Need:

- Flat razor
- Scissors
- White Vinegar
- Goo Gone
- Mean Green Cleaner & Degreaser
- Rag
- Kitchen Brush
- ENEACRO Polisher, Rotary Car Buffer Polisher Waxer
- menzerna Heavy Cut Polishing Compound 400
- Jescar Power Lock Polymer Paint Sealant
- Boat Letters
- Blue Painters Tape

### Steps:

**Remove Old Letters** 

- 1. Soak a rag with white vinegar and place on old letters for an hour
- 2. Remove rag and scrap letters off using a flat razor blade
- 3. Clean off remaining residue with goo gone

Clean Boat

- 4. Clean boat hull with Mean Green Cleaner & Degreaser with kitchen brush and allow to completely dry
- 5. Using a buffer and Heavy Cut Polishing Compound 400 to deoxidize the gel-coat
- 6. Apply a new gel coat protector using the Power Lock Polymer Paint Sealant
- 7. Wash again with degreaser and allow to completely dry

Add New Letters

- 8. Following the instructions that came with the letters, we cut the sides into 3 separate sections
- 9. Positioned and secured the letters with tape
- 10. Removed the liner and applied the letters to the boat
- 11. Carefully removed the transfer tape
